Competition Rules:

- Athletes must hold a minimum of a Virtus national eligibility and valid competition license (for details consult your Virtus member organisation).
- Each entry must be administered on a Concept2r Rowing Machine (Model C,D,E or Dynamic).
- The athlete and the entire erg must be in view for the entire row.
- The witness must zoom in on the monitor after the row as a part of the video submission. Separate pictures will not be accepted.

Entry procedure:

- Entry may only be made by Virtus member organisations using the online form that will be available from 10 February.
- Submissions must be made using the online form - entries made by email or other file transfer sites will not be accepted.
- There is no limit to the number of entries each athlete can make.

Prize:

The highest-ranking athletes on 31st March will receive a complimentary 1-year athlete competition license.
