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# 1. SPORTS PROGRAM

#### Accreditation / Badges

Accreditations will be distributed at the accommodation on Saturday 08 March. We will check your identity using your passport. Everyone must carry their accreditation with them at all times during the week.

Each athlete will have his or her own race number, which we will collect at the end of each race to make sure nothing is forgotten. We give them to you at the end of the competition.

#### Technical meeting and Race committee meeting

The technical and information meeting for heads of delegation and coaches will take place on Sunday 9 March at 3pm in a room at the La Bessanaise hotel.

For each race on the following day, a race committee meeting for the coaches will be held at the La Bessanaise hotel at 6pm on Monday 10 March, Tuesday 11 March and Wednesday 12 March.

At these meetings, we will give you all the technical and sporting information on the following day's race (rules, starlist, etc.).

#### • Provisional programme

### • Race start configuration:

- Men's and women's individual classic: individual starts every 30 seconds
- > Men's and women's Classic sprint: qualification individual start every 15 seconds. Then start by group 1/2 final 12 best times and final 6 best times
- Men's and Women's Relay: start in a line all at the same time at the signal. Placement on the start line according to the ranking from the last Seefield 2023 World Championships.
- Mass start: start in a row at the same time on signal. Placement on the start line according to the ranking of the last Seefield 2023 World Championships.

### Training time

- > Day: Sunday 09 March 2025
- > The competition tracks are at your disposal between 9am and 2.45pm and will be prepared with markers. Training is free, so there are no specific sessions for each delegation. You can come whenever you like between 9am and 2.45pm and stay as long as you like. Be sure to respect the lunchtimes in your accommodation and the technical meeting of the heads of delegation and coaches will take place at 3pm at the Hotel de la Bessanaise.
- > We must ask you to respect the slopes, nature and the ski area. In addition, please ensure that each team gets on well with the others. Fair play and cohesion are essential in our sport.

### • Warm-up and track reconnaissance (before the race):

The tracks will be available one hour before the start of the first race for everyone (men and women):

- > 8.30 am for the individual classic and the sprint classic.
- > 8.00 am for the relays and the mass start.

Remember to take a pair of training skis for the warm-up during the free ski races, the relay and the mass start (waxing protocol applied). See Waxing Charter.

#### Medal ceremony

- > Men's podium II1 / II2 / II3 : 15 min after the end of the women's race.
- > Women's podium II1 : 45 min after the end of the women's race

#### Rest area

The competition site is located on the Carreley biathlon stadium. It is located right next to the Carreley building (4 min walk).

Rest area: Each delegation will have a place under a tent next to the finish and start area. Each tent is heated and has an electric socket. To warm up and wait, you can also go to the rest area in the Carreley building.

#### • Track formats





#### • Relay

The men's relay consists of 3 athletes for a total distance of 7.5km. Each athlete must complete a 2.5km loop.

The women's relay consists of 2 athletes for a total distance of 5 km. Each athlete must complete a 2.5km loop.

# 3. TRANSPORT

This section only concerns those delegations who have confirmed that they will be responsible for their transfer from the airport to Bessans.

Departures and arrivals will take place at Lyon-Saint-Exupéry airport. The airport is 224 kilometres from Bessans.

#### • Arrival

A bus team will meet you at the exit and accompany you to the bus. Bus departures have been scheduled and grouped according to your arrival times. The buses will take you directly to your accommodation.

The volunteers will have your flight details and the contact details of each delegation. We will give you the contact details of the volunteers who will welcome you.

#### • Departure

Departure for Lyon-Saint-Exupéry airport will be on the night or morning of 14 March. We have grouped the departures into 2 buses. We will give you the departure time from the hotel during the week of 10 March.

# 4. ACCOMMODATION AND CATERING

Delegations will be accommodated in two different hotels. The hotels will be informed of your arrival time and a team will welcome you in the best conditions.

As a reminder, the hotels are strictly non-smoking. Any damage will be investigated and may result in financial penalties.

Catering will be full board in your hotels (breakfast, lunch and dinner). Any dietary restrictions have been taken into account and passed on to the hotel catering services.

Full board will begin with dinner on 8 March and end with breakfast on 14 March. Delegations leaving before breakfast on 14 March will be given a doggy bag.


