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1. TIGNES

Located in the Haute Tarentaise region of Savoie, the commune of Tignes is divided into 8 villages and hamlets at altitudes ranging from 1550 m to 2100 m. The municipality of Tignes is surrounded by the highest peaks in Savoie, such as Grande Casse and Grande Sassière, and the Vanoise National Park, a wilderness nature reserve that stretches across the Vanoise massif between the Tarentaise and Maurienne valleys. Renowned worldwide for the quality of its skiing and its dynamism, Tignes is also an inclusive and innovative community. Tignes has decided to take its future in hand: the quality of life of its 2,000 inhabitants all year round and the area's transition to the effects of climate change are at the heart of the term of office's projects.

It is prepared and equipped throughout the winter season, with timing facilities, safety equipment and piste maintenance, to host competitions from the youngest categories up to races of the highest international level.

The altitude, between 2105 and 2662 m, ensures excellent snow conditions, and another highlight is the finish area in the heart of the resort. Even if this slope requires a very good level of technique, it remains easily accessible.

A team of Tignes resort professionals is dedicated exclusively to supporting, assisting and organizing events on the Lognan stadium.

2. SPORT INFORMATION

• Stadium Lognan

The Lognan Stadium is FIS- homologated for all Slalom, Super G, Giant Slalom and Alpine Combined disciplines and used exclusively for competitions.

The competition site is located on the Lognan stadium. It is located right next to Tichot Chairlift. Even if this slope can be described as demanding, for our VIRTUS World Championship, we have chosen the starting point for each event, SG, GS and SL, and therefore the vertical drop, which while remaining within the VIRTUS rules, will enable all athletes to express their potential and demonstrate, if need be, the legitimacy of returning to the Paralympic Games.



The Lognan stadium is located in Tignes Val Claret. The stadium is served by the TICHOT and GRATTALU chairlifts.

Next to the finish area, take the « Tichot » chairlift. From the top of this chairlift, you can reach the start of the Giant Slalom, Special Slalom and Alpine Combined events. To get to the start of the Super G race from the arrival station of the Tichot chairlift, descend (approx. 400 m) to the « Grattalu » chairlift, then reach (600 m) the arrival station of the "Merles" chairlift. The Lognan stadium starts to the right of the Merles chairlift station.



Toilets: Toilets are available next to the finish area and at the top of the Tichot chairlift

Rest area athlete: rest areas and equipment storage will be available to each delegation. Each country will have its own area

3. SPORTS PROGRAM

Accreditation / Badges

Accreditations will be distributed at the accommodation on Sunday 30 March. We will check your identity using your passport. Everyone must carry their accreditation with them at all times during the week.

Each athlete will have his or her bibs race number, which we will collect at the end of each race to make sure nothing is forgotten. We give them to you at the end of the competition.

• Technical meeting and Race committee meeting

The technical and information meeting for heads of delegation and coaches will take place on Monday 31 March at 2.30 pm in a room at Tignespace.

During Training session: Race Director, Christian Gianese, will meet the head coaches from each nation at the start of the TICHOT chairlift at 11am (Monday 31 March) for a technical inspection of the Lognan stadium and the various Super G, Slalom and Giant Slalom starts.

There won't be a committee meeting every day, but daily information will be given on the Whatsapp group or after the second run.

The organisers reserve the right to modify or adapt the race depending on the weather and snow conditions.

SLOPE DESCRIPTION:

The first part is relatively flat before entering a number of terrain changes where speed accelerates with the "Bosse à David", then the "Bosse Rossignol" and the "Mur des



Tufs". This is followed by a long traverse which leads to a large left-hand curve and the finishing wall.

ACCESS:

Take the "Tichot" chairlift. Ski down to the left to reach the "Grattalu" chairlift. Use the slope to the finish of the "Merles" chairlift (pick up speed to get back to the chairlift arrival station). To the right of the arrival station begins the Lognan stadium. Follow the piste to the start of the Super G.

SLOPE DESCRIPTION:

The start of the Alpine Combined Super G is in the same place as the start of the Giant Slalom. The start of the Alpine Combined Special Slalom is located slightly below the start of the Special Slalom.



ACCESS:

Take the "Tichot" chairlift. At the arrival station, take the track on the right that leads directly to the start of the Super G. Take the same chairlift and slope to reach the start of the Special Slalom: start in a row at the same time on signal. Placement on the start line according to the ranking of the last Seefield 2023 World Championships.

• Training time

Monday 31 March 2025

On the lower part of the competition site, a Giant slalom training run (around 15-20 gates) and a slalom run will be set up from 9am (when the chairlift opens). These runs are available between 9.00am and 12.30pm (reconnaissance and training).

Access: take the Tichot chairlift only

We must ask you to respect the slopes, nature and the ski area. In addition, please ensure that each team gets on well with the others. Fair play and cohesion are essential in our sport.

Race Director, Christian Gianese, will meet the head coaches from each nation at the start of the TICHOT chairlift at 11am (Monday 31 March) for a technical inspection of the Lognan stadium and the various Super G, Slalom and Giant Slalom starts.

• Warm-up and track reconnaissance (before the race):

The tracks will be available one hour before the start of the first race for everyone (men and women):

> 9.00 am for everybody at the opening chairlift

Waxing

Waxing can be done in the hotel where you are staying. A dedicated area will be set up.

Medal ceremony

All podiums will take place after the second run (slalom, giant slalom and alpine combined) or after the first run of the Super G. Please check the timetable on the provisional program. The medal ceremony will take place next to the race finish area. Medallists must go to the chalet 10 minutes before the medal ceremony to prepare for the podiums. PLEASE.



4. TRANSPORT

This section only concerns those delegations who have confirmed that they will be responsible for their transfer from the airport to Tignes.

Departures and arrivals will take place at Lyon-Saint-Exupéry airport. The airport is 221 kilometres from Tignes Val Claret.

Some delegations arrive at Geneva International Airport. The airport is 180 kilometres from Tignes Val Claret.

• Arrival

For arrivals before March 30th in Lyon or Geneva

Buses have been programmed and grouped according to your arrival times. They will have your flight details and the contact details of the head of delegation. We will also provide you with the driver's contact details. The buses will take you directly to your accommodation.

For arrivals on March 30th in Lyon

A volunteer team will meet you at the exit and accompany you to the bus. Bus departures have been scheduled and grouped according to your arrival times. The buses will take you directly to your accommodation. The volunteers will have your flight details and the contact details of each delegation. We will give you the contact details of the volunteers who will welcome you.

For arrivals on March 30th in Geneva

Buses have been programmed and grouped according to your arrival times. They will have your flight details and the contact details of the head of delegation. We will also provide you with the driver's contact details.

The buses will take you directly to your accommodation.

For arrivals from March 28th onwards, the Australian, USA and Finnish delegations will be contacted by e-mail with transport information.

• Departure

Departure for Lyon-Saint-Exupéry airport will be around 6.30 am. Departure for Geneva international airport will be around 4.30 am. Timetables will be confirmed at the beginning of the competition week. Departures from your hotel on April 5th. For delegations staying on their own, we will inform you of the meeting point in Tignes Val Claret.

5. LOCAL TRANSPORT


Town shuttles drive throughout the day and evening between the various Tignes resorts.


On 4 April, following the medal ceremony, the World Championships will close with a parade of flag bearers from each country and the lowering of the Virtus flag.
